The Skip is 4 2 wall a country line dance with three step patterns. The dance begins facing one wall and progressively changes facing by one wall counter counter-clockwise (L) around the room/dance space with each repeat. Presented here as learned from Niji Vostal at an Argonne IFD dance evenings.

Choreography: P. Griffiths, 20 counts, 4 wall dance

Suggested Music: *Down at the Twist and Shout by Mary Chapin Carpenter

Facings: During the dance sequence, dancers progress 1/4 turn CCW, or left, to face the next wall

Steps	Counts				
	and	1 - Q	And - Q	2 - S	and
Vine/Grapevine		side	behind	side	pause &/or kick the free foot
Rock steps		forward	backward	forward	hop or lift and kick
Skip(s)	hop	step	hop	step	(hop, optional)

Dance Sequence:

Measures

- 1 Left grapevine with an optional kick
- 2 Right grapevine, finishing with a 1/4 turn to the Right and an optional kick
- 3 Rock steps beginning Left forward, Right backward, Left forward, make a half turn (180 degree) CCW (Left) pivoting on Left foot on count 2 and
- 4 Rock steps beginning Right forward, Left backward, Right forward and kick Left foot forward
- 5 Skip steps beginning hop Left hop Right (hop optional a lift works well)

The dance repeats until the music ends.

Note: The dance sequence is 5 measures of music and crosses the musical phrases. This is common in country line dancing.

I think of the dance as 4 measures of QQSs and one of 2 step hops.
