## MALEŠEVSKO ORO

## Pirinska Makedonia (Bulgaria)

This version of *Maleševsko Oro* is one of the orginal dances from the repertoir of the villagers of Piperovo in West-Macedonia. Other versions are known in the villages in the stream area of the Struma river between the Bulgarian towns of Petric and Sandansko. The dance was originally associated and done by the migrant workers who went abroad (usually in Greece) to look for work during harvest times. *Gurbetcijsko Horo* means "dance of the seasonal labourers". Another name for the same dance *Čestoto* ("often"). Originally performed to Zurna and Tapan accompaniment, nowadays the dance is often done to popular folksongs such as: *Aj Da Idem Jano*, *Kicice*, *Sedna lo e Djore* and *Dimitria*.

Meas: 2/4

Style: Macedonian / Pirinsko. Light and bouncy. When the music gets faster, the bounces

become hops and the lifts become kicks.

Intro: Slow rubato sing

DANCE DESCRIPTION

Meas 1 - 2 FOUR WALKING STEPS Facing and moving LOD, 4 walking steps R,L,R,L (cts 1,2,3,4)

Meas 3-4 TWO THREE-STEPS
"Fall" onto R ft with a dip (ct 1), step on Lft (ct 2), step on R ft (ct&)
"Fall" onto L ft with a dip (ct 1), step on Rft (ct 2), step on L ft (ct&)

Meas 5-7 THREE BALANCES
Facing ctr., dancing in place,
step on R ft (ct 1), bounce on R ft lifting L knee in front (ct 2)
step on L ft tw ctr (ct 1), bounce on L ft lifting L knee in front (ct 2)
step on R ft bkw (ct 1), bounce on R ft lifting L knee in front (ct 2)

Meas 8-9 FOUR WALKING STEPS - GRAPEVINE Facing ct., moving sdwd L step on L ft step on R ft in front of L ft step on L ft step on L ft step on Lt

Meas 10-12 THREE BALANCES
Repeat action of Meas 5-7 with opp ftw & directions
